- \$300** Sponsors one computer class with up-to-date technology each year.
- \$600/YR.** Keeps a student safe and educated.
- \$1,500/YR.** Provides a motivated young adult with a University scholarship.

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# TACKLING PROBLEMS IN A POST-GENOCIDE COMMUNITY

For half a decade, Cambodia was ravaged by civil war at the hands of dictator Pol Pot and the Khmer Rouge. Roughly two million people, or a quarter of the population, were murdered, especially the educated class.

Today, Cambodia's legacy of hardship and trauma manifests in:



- POVERTY
- MALNUTRITION
- CHILD LABOR
- CHILD TRAFFICKING
- LACK OF EDUCATION
- CHILD ABUSE

**32%** of Cambodian children under five have stunted growth due to malnutrition (USAID, 2018)

**19%** of Cambodian children are exploited as child laborers (UNICEF, 2018)

**9<sup>TH</sup>** Cambodia is ranked 9th out of 167 countries on the Global Slavery Index (Global Slavery Index, 2018)

**68%** of girls and 54% of boys in Cambodia experience violence in their childhood (UNICEF 2018).

## A holistic approach to child empowerment

*Our integrated programs work together to address each student's needs in and out of the classroom:*



### PROTECTION

We provide all of our students access to healthcare and social work support to ensure that no child we work with is malnourished, trafficked, exploited or abused. We assess their needs for food, shelter, family-based care, protection, health, psychosocial development and education.

### EDUCATION

Our supplementary education program at CFI's Learning Center gets students up to speed and into school. Then students are ready to receive a first-class supplementary education from CFI's teachers in math, Khmer (Cambodian Language), English and IT. We also offer programs for social development, life skills and employment readiness.

### COMMUNITY

We run regular family workshops to educate the community on the problems affecting them such as safe migration, managing finances, positive parenting and family hygiene. We also offer regular capacity building for our staff, to ensure we are always delivering the best possible services.
